NACS will offer 9 awards and 3 honourable mentions

The National Agency of Civil Servants has completed the evaluation phase for the applications to the 5th edition of the *Competition of best practices in the Romanian public administration*. The 59 projects entered in the competition were evaluated by a jury of academic experts, NGOs and media, based on two evaluation scales.

We remind that the projects submitted have addressed different aspects of the same issues, being distributed on three pillars of the competition as follows:

- Institutional responsibility and involvement in support of vulnerable social groups – 32 projects
- Protection and promotion of national heritage in cooperation with civil society – 5 projects
- Implementation of institutional communication mechanisms in the service of citizens – 22 projects

We cannot reveal the names of the winners until the 9 awards and 3 honourable mentions will be offered in the International Conference “Innovation and Quality in the Public Sector”, 5th Edition (June 28, 2012), but we can let you know that the first prizes go to local public administration.

“This edition of the competition was fierce, as usual, demonstrating the professionalism of human resources in public administration and encouraging NACS to be further involved in identifying and promoting best practices in the Romanian public sector”, said NACS President, Eugen Coifan.
