NACS was awarded an appreciation from the European Commission

At the end of July 2012, the National Agency of Civil Servants received the **label Best Editor's Choice** from the European Commission's ePractice.eu portal for the Case Study *European Standards in ICT Use for Public Administration in Romania*, published on this site.

Therefore, the Case Study, which is based on an externally-financed project developed by NACS, was viewed by many users of the e-Practice portal, gaining a pan-European visibility and proving the relevance and importance of the Agency's activity in implementing such projects.

The awarding of this quality label to the institution comes as the National Agency of Civil Servants may be considered an example of Best Practice in attracting and successfully using EU funds. Currently, NACS is also implementing **4 externally-financed projects**, while **other 3 projects** are to be financed, after having passed the evaluation stage.

We also restate that the project *European Standards in ICT Use for Public Administration – National Certification Program for Civil Servants*, SMIS Code 2773, developed by NACS since August 2009 until February 2012, aimed at developing PC skills, internationally recognised by receiving the European Computer Driving Licence (ECDL), for a number of **12.000 civil servants**.
