More than 6,000 persons trained by NACS in 2012

The National Agency of Civil Servants (NACS) presents the main milestones of the work carried out during 2012:

As regards implementing projects with external financing, NACS managed/manages as beneficiary and partner, **8 projects financed through Structural Funds** in the aggregate amount of **RON 69,375,257.65**, i.e. **EUR 15,416,723.92**. Thus, in 2012, a number of **1,714 persons** received training through European projects.

Also, NACS has developed a series of specific training activities for staff in public administration, civil servants and contractual staff. **4,200 people** attended the **215 training programs** organized by NACS in partnership with training providers. To these are added the **120 participants** who completed the training modules in the Specialized Training Programme for the Category of Senior Civil Servants.

We emphasize that in 2012, the national records of civil servants and civil service positions were achieved through an **integrated information system** existing in the Agency. During 2012, the number of public authorities and institutions whose structures of civil service positions are managed through the integrated information system has grown from **4,423** to **4,485**, representing over **99%** of public authorities and institutions in Romania currently holding such structures. Also, **the flow of data transmission and reception on records of civil service positions is performed online** and the **electronic signature system** has been implemented in the department with responsibilities in the management of civil service and civil servants.

Regarding regulatory activities **19 draft laws were initiated** and the **procedure was carried on** for another total of **5 draft laws** initiated during 2011 in areas such as: management of civil service positions and civil servants, specialized training activity. In order to ensure the necessary conditions to change primary legislation, the work to promote the public policy draft "Developing ethical standards in public administration" has continued, the draft being subject to public debate.

In the field of international relations activities of the Agency, in 2012 **entered into force the cooperation agreement with the Academy of Public Administration under the President of the Republic of Moldova** which covers civil service issues.

"In the coming period, NACS will follow clear action directions in line with social realities, courses of action that ensure the professional management of civil service and civil servants", is the message of NACS President, Eugen Coifan.
