European Commission's initiative aims at awarding the **nine most innovative projects** run by public authorities from Europe. The themes of projects enlisted in the competition are improving citizens' lives, supporting firms and stimulating research and education.

Through this Prize, the European Commission, through the Directorate-General for Research and Innovation intends to reward excellence and innovation which have the potential to be replicated in other European contexts.

Submission of applications is made online and the **deadline** is **15 February 2013**.
