EPSA 2013 Awards: Romania applied with 14 projects

News

The National Agency of Civil Servants (NACS) informs that at the 2013 edition of the *European Public Sector Award (EPSA2013)* entitled „*Weathering the Storm: Creative Solutions in a Time of Crisis*” there were registered 230 applications (26 European states and institutions). Of these, 15 applications have been nominated for EPSA 2013 and 47 received certificates of good practice, including the application of the Ministry of Public Finance of Romania - Central Harmonisation Unit for Public Internal Audit - „*Partnership for internal audit in local administration*”. Moreover, with 14 listed projects, Romania is among the leading countries, along with Spain (46), Poland (36), Italy (18) and Portugal (14).

This performance is primarily due to the **efforts of representatives of public institutions and authorities** who understand that promoting results is an important step in achieving institutional objectives and ensuring an effective public service.

Equally, this performance is due to NACS’s involvement in actions related to the promotion and dissemination of outstanding achievements of public administration, and the promotion of international initiatives among civil servants in Romania. We mention the involvement in nationally promoting *the Quality Conference*, an initiative of the Presidency of the EU Council, *the European Public Sector Award*, the *UN Awards for Public Administration*, in undertaking the *Competition of best practices in the Romanian public administration* and in organizing *the International Conference „Innovation and quality in the Public Sector”* (already at its sixth edition).

Please note that the EPSA 2013 awards ceremony will take place on 25-27 November 2013 in Maastricht, Netherlands.
