NACS learns from France

News

A delegation of the National Agency of Civil Servants (NACS), led by Eugen COIFAN, NACS President, participated in the period 16 to 22 June 2013 to a study tour aimed at exchanging best practices at European level in the Member States with relevant experience in managing civil service.

The event was organized within the project „Increasing public administration capacity to manage civil servants’ recruitment, selection and evaluation processes in the context of increasing accountability of public administration for civil service management” SMIS Code 35032 and it was held in Paris, France.

NACS representatives met with representatives of government institutions in France, having relevant experience in civil service management, such as the National School of Administration (ENA), National Centre of Territorial Public Service, Interdepartmental Management Center, French Ministry of the Interior’s Centre for Advanced Studies - CHEMI, French Departments Assembly (ADF), the Directorate General of Civil Service Administration (DGAFP) etc.

NACS participation in the study visit was particularly timely given that the information and contacts gained will be an important element in its efforts to streamline HR processes, also one of the results taken under the above-mentioned project. Moreover, the visit provided an opportunity for writing documentation for future requests for funding for the administration in Romania, applicable to civil servants and civil service.
