NACS attended a seminar within the Eastern Partnership

On 21 October 2014, József Birtalan, the president of the National Agency of Civil Servants (NACS) participated in Warsaw (Poland) at the seminar within the Public Administration Reform Panel of the Eastern Partnership (EaP) - Standards of recruitment and selection to the senior positions in the civil service and political-administrative interface in the EU and EaP member states, organized by the Civil Service Department in Poland.

The seminar brought together **top managers** and **experts responsible for the civil service reform**, including recruitment and selection procedure from EU Member States and partner countries - Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Moldova and Ukraine, among attendees being the Head of Civil Service in Poland, the Director of the Human Resources Directorate General of the European Commission and the Director of the National School of Public Administration in Poland.

The event was divided into three workshops were held presentations of centralized, decentralized or joint recruitment and selection models for management positions in public administration. Discussions also focused on the political-administrative interface of this process.

Present to the event, besides NACS president, the representative of the Civil Service Management General Direction gave a presentation on the recruitment and selection of managerial civil service positions in Romania, focusing on management civil servants, as well as on senior civil servants.

The **Public Administration Reform Panel** is a thematic workgroup within the Eastern Partnership, founded in October 2011, coordinated by the European Commission by the External Action Service (EEAS), Romania being represented on the Panel since the first meeting.
