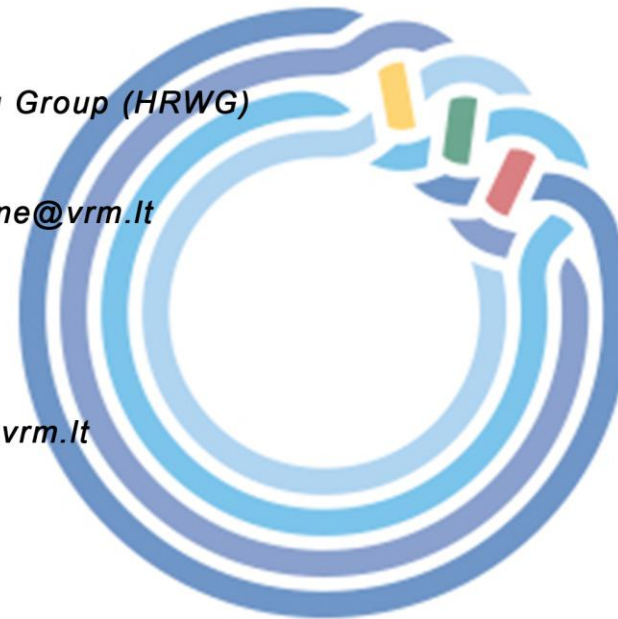

THE LITHUANIAN EUPAN PRESIDENCY

The Lithuanian Presidency takes the lead of EUPAN in the second half of 2013, and continues to implement the Medium Term Priorities and the 18 month work programme (1 January 2013 – 30 June 2014) approved during the Cyprus Presidency.

The Lithuanian Presidency will ensure the continuity of the implementation of Medium Term Plan (MTP), which has been developed by Lithuania, Ireland and Greece.

The horizontal theme of the MTP „**Delivering a more resilient, professional and responsive Public Administration to the citizen**“ will be unfolded into three pillar themes:

- > A „fit for purpose“ Public Administration (resilient)
- > The role of the human resources function in shaping Public Administration (professional)
- > Connecting to the citizen (responsive)

Each of the pillar themes will be explored through national and international case studies, surveys and relevant presentations. The Lithuanian Presidency will try to ensure the favourable atmosphere for fruitful discussions among EUPAN members and invited guests.

The Lithuanian Presidency would like to invite and encourage all members of EUPAN to actively participate in the EUPAN meetings and share their knowledge and experience for the purpose to reach common goals that are relevant for Public Administrations of the Member States.
