## NACS at a round table with the employers and the trade unions

Today, 25<sup>th</sup> of July 2018, the National Agency of Civil Servants and the National Federation of Trade Unions of Administration from Romania (FNFA), organized in Bucharest, a roundtable dedicated to the field of posted workers.

The event is an activity of the project entitled *Overcoming challenges in the field of posting of workers through joint cooperation of social partners from public sector* implemented by the Independent Trade Union Coalition from Madrid, Spain, in partnership with other organizations from 9 different countries, including Romania and funded via the European Program for Employment and Social Innovation (EaSI).

During the event, the project's results were disseminated and multiplied, the roundtable simultaneously representing an opportunity for those in direct contact with this area, to debate fundamental aspects referring to the process of applying the **European directive 96/71/CE concerning the posting of workers in the framework of the provision of services.**

**NACS' invitation gathered representatives of the Ministry of Labour and Social Justice, the Labour Inspection, as well as representatives of certain employers and trade union confederations.**

The president of NACS, Vasile – Felix Cozma, present at the event, thanked everybody for their participation, reinforcing the importance of partnerships in the Agency's activity:
