Today, October 30, 2020, Prime Minister Ludovic Orban signed the appointment of Violeta Vijulie as president of the National Agency of Civil Servants (NACS). To this day, Vijulie has held the position of vice-president of the Agency. From the position of vice-president, Violeta Vijulie managed, in only a few months, to attract European funds worth 12,000,000 RON that will be used for the creation of E-budget - the database with all public employees in Romania, for piloting the National Competition dedicated to the recruitment of civil servants and to the training of 7,500 people in the fields of human resources management and digitization.
